Date Claimer: “Deep Listening” Session - The next “Deep Listening” Session will be held on Saturday afternoon **28th of February 2-4pm** at the Faber Centre 111 Sir Samuel Griffith Drive Bardon. This session will be its size, good conference facilities, and air conditioning. The day and timing will allow busy family members to attend. It will also suit elderly parishioners who do not want to drive at night. The theme of this “Deep Listening” session will be “Ways Forward”. Participants are invited to articulate what the Parish means for them and what their vision for the Parish is.

Many of the things that the participants of previous “Deep Listening” Sessions wanted to see established (like a Liturgy Committee) have already being implemented or wanted to see re-established (like a Children’s Liturgy) are in the planning stage. Speedy implementation of the things that need to be done is a key characteristic of genuine Synodality.

This “Deep Listening” session is not a complaints bureau. It about what participants see as the longer term spiritual nourishment and other needs of the Parish.

Nuts and bolts things such as financing cleaning of the Church, air-conditioning the Church Hall, and maintenance items are already being assessed. Thanks to Nev Feeney and the parish secretary we have a comprehensive list of minor works and maintenance items for the Parish Pastoral Council to prioritise and fund.

There are several notices we didn’t have room for which are now **on the noticeboard**. These include **Fr Frank’s** event, **Indooroopilly Centenary** and Toowong Parish events.

The ‘**Sacramental Preparation Programme**’ in our ‘Community of Communities’ will run over two years; commencing with Confirmation (generally year 3), then followed by First Penance (Reconciliation) and First Holy Communion (generally year 4). Enrolments for Sacrament of First Penance are now open. Any new enrolments **deadline is 3.00pm Friday 6 March**. You can find information on our website and noticeboard.

The **World Day of Prayer** is a global ecumenical movement led by Christian women who come together to observe a common day of prayer each year. Our local World Day of Prayer hour this year will be held at our church St Thomas Aquinas at **10.30am on Friday 6th March**. The prayers have been prepared by the **women of Nigeria**.
