Today marks the beginning of HOLY WEEK. It is **Palm Sunday.** 

Palms will be blessed at the beginning of Mass and left around the Church for people to take home. If you would like to make a **palm cross** from the leaves that are blessed, there is an **instruction leaflet** available as well. Blest palms are to be put in the **garden**, and not in the rubbish bin when no longer needed.
